



## User's Guide

*Principles and Choices* is a complete 9<sup>th</sup>— 12<sup>th</sup> grade high school curriculum, which teaches key principles to help students make good choices throughout their lives. The entire curriculum is based on the book *Ten Universal Principles: A Brief Philosophy of the Life Issues*, by Robert J. Spitzer, S.J., Ph.D.

Principles and Choices uses contemporary, high quality student texts, teacher materials, and multimedia resources. The series may be used as a supplement within Elective C: Living as a Disciple of Jesus Christ in Society, based on the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' Doctrinal Elements of a Curriculum Framework for the Development of Catechetical Materials for Young People of High School Age, 2007 (Curriculum Framework).

There are three books in the *Principles and Choices* series, each with four chapters. We recommend teaching each book in a four-week time frame in each grade – Book One in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade, Book Two in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade, and Book Three in the 11<sup>th</sup> grade.
