GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS for Administering Principles & Choices Assessments

- 1. You will be given **links to the assessment surveys at CARA's website** in advance of your preand post-test dates.
- 2. The PRE-test should be given to students before the distribution of any *Principles & Choices* materials.
- 3. Each student must have access to a computer to take the test and must complete the test with the entire class in one place that is, in your school under your supervision. PRE- and

POST-tests cannot be taken at home or in another location where the student might be influenced by onlookers. If you are unable to have your entire class take the test at the same time, or do not have access to computers, please contact us to discuss other options.

- 4. Simply administer the corresponding **POST-test** after each book is completed: POST-test 1 should be given after completing Book 1, POST-test 2 after Book 2, and POST-test 3 after Book 3. The PRE-test should be given only once.
- 5. **The last step** is for each teacher to complete the **Teacher Evaluation** survey.

PRE-TEST DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Have students go to: https://cara.georgetown.edu/online-surveys/ and scroll down to the heading for Principles & Choices. Here they will see links for the Principles & Choices assessments. Have the students click on Pre-test for Students (or use the following shortened URL for quick access to the pre-test: https://bit.ly/2MJae9h).
- 2. Read the following instructions aloud:

Today, we are going to complete a brief assessment conducted by the Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate (CARA) at Georgetown University. The purpose of this is to better understand the viewpoints of students across the United States on selected topics.

This survey is completely anonymous and confidential. I will not see your answers. No useable information about your identity is collected. Your answers should accurately reflect your thoughts.

It will take about 10 minutes to finish the survey. Go ahead and begin!

- 3. This is NOT a group test, so please **do not allow the students to talk to each other** about the questions or their answers.
- 4. Once all your students have completed the PRE-test, you can distribute the Principles & Choices materials and begin your planned instruction in the Principles & Choices curriculum.

POST-TEST DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **There is a different POST-test** for each of the three books in the *Principles & Choices* series. (Remember, the PRE-test is given only once prior to any instruction in the curriculum.)
- 2. Each POST-test should be given within two weeks after completing the related *Principles & Choices* book.
- 3. Have students go to: https://cara.georgetown.edu/online-surveys/ and scroll down to the heading for **Principles & Choices**. Here they will see links for the *Principles & Choices* assessments. Have the students click on the appropriate **POST-test** link:

 - Book 2 "Truth and Reason" Post-test (or use the following shortened URL for quick access: https://bit.ly/2NDTrAZ)

- 4. Read the following instructions aloud:

This survey is completely anonymous. I will not see your answers. No useable information about your identity is collected. Your answers should accurately reflect your thoughts.
